Cart Plan ... The Cart Plan is \$795 per year. This plan includes unlimited cart usage for you and anyone covered under

your membership. An 18-hole cart fee if not on this plan will now cost you and or your guests \$20.00 + tax. (Guests, married children, children who do not live at home are all examples of people not covered under your membership). It will include (1) FREE Bag Storage, an \$85 value that also happens to be one of the best deals at the club. Also included are (10) FREE Guest Fees (\$400 Value) for you to use for friends, customers, and family when you treat them to play a round of golf. The Cart Plan member must be present when using free green fees. The in-county rule allowing guests to play only three times per year will still apply.

Driving range ... is open daily. We close the range at night at 5:00, with no balls being passed out after 4:30 until the time changes March 12th. The range will stay open longer as the days get longer. Wednesday nights are especially important to get the range closed on time, as daylight every Thursday morning is a full mowing of the entire range.

Reciprocal Agreement ... As a member of Owensboro Country Club, there will be days when we host an outside event that may inconvenient your plans to play golf a particular day. Keep in mind that we have a special arrangement with some of the other area clubs that will allow you as a member of OCC to go and play their club for a flat rate \$25 fee. This is a great deal for us as well as members of these other facilities. It gives you many options of places to play on days when there might be an outing. Listed below are the facilities that currently participate and their contact information. Again this year, TUESDAY from 5:30 until dark, the tee book will be blocked off to accommodate the Men's League on the entire golf course. The league starts at 5:30 on Tuesday nights. Find a partner who can play and sign-up now. The cost is \$75 per player and the league is set up so all the money goes back to the players, with roughly only a \$20 difference between first and last place team.

We hope that everyone enjoys the schedule we have set up for the members. Please remember too if there is an outside outing scheduled at the club, our staff will be happy to set your group a tee time for one of the reciprocal clubs we have available for you.

Club Repairs ... Take advantage of the off-season by making your old clubs feel like new again. We can get any grips that you like and stock many of the best grips in the game today. This is a small investment compared to the price of getting all new clubs. Any grips that are special ordered will usually arrive and can be on your clubs within 3-5 days. And don't forget about your lofts and lie angles. We have a lie/loft machine in house and can check your clubs to make sure they meet your specifications. This is an important process and something that can improve your game and help you become a better player.

So far we have not had much of a winter snow wise. One light dusting of snow may be all we get this winter. December has been the coldest month this winter, which is very odd. Most of our work days have been outside this winter. We have spent much of our time trimming the fence along JR Miller. This year we took off much more material

on the inside than years past. Some areas had up to 3 feet of outward growth removed. We recently started to replace steps in #12 tee bank. We used 6" x 6" treated timbers instead of railroad ties. The 6 x 6 timbers make for a much nicer finished product. The railroad ties are hard to work

with due to varied size, plus they are getting to be difficult to find on a regular basis. We will continue trimming trees and replacing bunker drainage in the next few weeks. The turf usually starts to consistently grow by the second or third week of March. This year it may be before that.

Don't forget about the time change on March 12th. Sunrise will happen just after 7 a.m. on that day. On frosty mornings it will cause the morning golfers to wait longer before the course is ready to play. Our daily course preparations will need to be delayed until after sunrise and in a situation when we have frost, our start could be as late as 9 or 10 a.m. into the morning, delaying golf even longer. This will only be the case for a few short weeks. So, I just ask for your understanding when dealing with circumstances that we can not control.
