## Kevin's Klippings

I hope everyone who participated enjoyed the Member-Guest Classic. Congratulations to the winners! Jason and staff put on a fantastic event once again. The golf maintenance staff labors many hours on the days leading to these types of events. Your grounds crew did a great job in tough, hot and dry conditions. As always, we enjoy preparing the course for special events. All your positive

comments were well received by the golf maintenance crew. Thank You!

June and July were very dry except for about a 5 day period around the holiday. We have many areas of stressed out turf. Cart traffic continues to make the turf look worse. We have been recommending "fairways only" to limit traffic in the roughs. If you see brown tire tracks or dormant brown turf, do not drive through it. Driving on dry turf does just as much damage as driving on frosty turf in the winter.

I am seeing some troubles in the longer turf around greens. Several things are going on to cause these areas to be less than

perfect. The interface where the bermuda and fescue meet we are experiencing some clumpiness (scientific term – not a real word). Bermuda is a low spreading turf where fescue is a clump type turf. We have increased fertilizer to kick start the bermuda with hopes it thickens up. Basically neither turf is doing well and growing at far different rates. Secondly, we had a massive disease outbreak in early July when we did have rain. Dollar spot and brown patch hit both grasses hard and completely killed out any annual bluegrass (poa) that was still there leaving large brown voids. Then we also have few persistent weeds we are fighting off: nutsedge and kylinga. Both which we seem to be getting more of each year and are somewhat difficult to control. We have made one herbicide application so far and we will need to follow-up with another after we get out of the upper 80's and 90 degree days.

The plan moving forward is to better define the bermuda/fescue transition in front of greens. We will try to chemically remove some of the small fescue clumps. We may remove some fescue that is really close to collars and sod bermuda in its place. Later in the summer/early fall we will continue to aerify and seed fescue where we don't want bermuda. A preventative fungicide program will be needed to prevent disease in the future. This will take additional funding. Nothing with turf is an easy overnight fix and I appreciate your patience.
